On August 2, 2015, at about 5:47 AM members of the Hudson Police Department and Hudson Fire Department responded to a collision involving a Tractor/Trailer Unit and an automobile. Upon arrival, occupants were attended to for injuries and an investigation ensued.

During the initial investigation it was determined a 2014 Chevrolet Cruze was traveling south on Lowell Road near 142 Lowell Road. It was operated by Karen Provencher, 38 years old, of Hudson, NH. She was the lone occupant. A 2014 Mack Truck with a 2012 Trailer attached was traveling north on Lowell Road in the same area. It was operated by Thomas Leblanc, 44 years old, of Sabattus, ME.

The Chevrolet crossed into the north bound lane and struck the rear axle of the trailer portion of the unit. The rear axle of the trailer dislaged and the trailer jack knifed causing all the travel lanes to be blocked.

Provencher was attended to on scene by Hudson Fire Personnell. She was transported to St Joseph Hospital in Nashua, NH for non-life threatening injuries. Leblanc suffered no apparent injuries.

The Chevrolet had multiple airbag deployment and heavy front left damage. It was towed from the scene. The road remained closed until the trailer could be removed from the roadway at 9:16 AM. The Mack was able to leave under its own power.

The cause of the crash is still under investigation.
