**On 5/26/2017 at approximately 5:49 am, the Hudson Police Department attempted to stop a 2002 Chrysler Voyager that was traveling at a high rate of speed west on Highland Street. The vehicle continued through the intersection of Highland Street and Derry Street in a reckless manner and at an extremely high rate of speed. The vehicle traveled through the intersection of Highland Street and Baker Street and came to a stop as it collided into the front of 12 Baker Street.**

**The driver of the vehicle was identified as, 19 year old Antonio Velazquez of 3 A Street, Hudson, NH. Velazquez suffered serious injuries and was transported to a Boston Hospital.**

**It was determined through an investigation that the 2002 Chrysler Voyager was stolen out of Nashua, NH. In the rear of the vehicle was a 2009 Ducatti motorcycle registered to another individual in Nashua, NH. NH State Police Collision Response Team is investigating the motor vehicle collision.**

**Mr. Velazquez is charged with , Reckless Conduct (Felony), Receiving Stolen Property (Felony) Reckless Operation, Disobeying an Officer, Operating Without a Valid Licesne, and Speeding. Mr. Velazquez will be arraigned on 6/22/2017 at the 9<sup>th</sup> Circuit Nashua District Court.**
