On December 8, 2017, at about 12:35 PM, the Hudson Police responded to Walmart, 254 Lowell Road, for a report of shoplifting. Upon arrival, officers made contact with Asset Protection personnel who had detained David Johnson, 28 years old of East Greenwich, RI for concealing two (2) Roku Ultra streaming devices and other merchandise on his person. He then left the store without paying. It was determined Johnson used snipping tools to cut the anti-theft devices off the packages.

He was subsequently arrested by the Hudson Police Department. At the time Johnson was arrested, officers located the snipping tool and another device designed to defeat anti-theft measures on his person. Johnson had arrived at Walmart in a 2017 Mazda 6, color black. The Hudson Police believe Johnson may have committed a similar theft or thefts of similar streaming devices elsewhere. Johnson was transported to the Hudson Police Department for booking. His bail was set at \$1500 Cash or Surety. He was bailed and is scheduled to be arraigned on January 11, 2018 at the 9th Circuit Court- Nashua District Division for the charges of Theft by Unauthorized Taking and Possession of Theft Detection Removers or Shielding Devices (two counts). All three charges are Class A Misdemeanors.
