On September 24, 2015, at about 4:07 PM, members of the Hudson Police Department and Hudson Fire Department responded to Wason Road near 56 Wason Road for a two vehicle collision. Upon arrival, members of the Hudson Fire Department and Police Department attended to the occupants. The Hudson Police Department began an investigation into the crash.

During the initial stages of the investigation, it was determined a 2013 Ford F-150 was traveling east on Wason Road. It was operated by Martin Flannery, 47 years old of Hudson, NH. He was the lone occupant.

A 2012 Chevrolet Silverado was traveling west on Wason Road. It was operated by Louise Dillon, 48 years old, of Hudson, NH. It was also occupied by her 17 year old daughter, of Hudson, NH. As the vehicles approached from opposite directions, the Ford traveled into the west bound lane and struck the Chevrolet head on. All occupants were treated on scene by the Hudson Fire Department. Both Louise Dillon and her daughter were transported to SNHMC for non-life threatening injuries. All occupants of both vehicles were seatbelted. The Chevrolet had dual airbag deployment. Both vehicles had to be towed from the scene.

Mr. Flannery was cited for traveling left of the double yellow highway markings, a violation. The cause of the collision is still under investigation.
