On June 27, 2017, at about 5:49 PM, the Hudson Police Department and the Hudson Fire Department responded to a single vehicle collision into a utility pole on Wason Road near 63 Wason Road.

Upon arrival, members of the Hudson Fire Department attended to the operator of a 2008 Nissan Altima. The Hudson Police began an investigation. Through the initial investigation, it was determined the Nissan Altima was traveling east on Wason Road near 63 Wason Road. It was operated by Ann Speer, 38 years old, of Hudson, NH. The vehicle drove off the road to the right striking a mail box and then colliding with a utility pole.

The vehicle sustained heavy front end damage and there was air bag deployment. Speer was taken to St Joseph Hospital for non life threatening injuries. She was not seat belted at the time of the crash. The collision resulted in damage to the mailbox and damage to the utility pole as well. Eversource was contacted to assess the damage.

Wason Road was reduced to one lane in the area for about 45 minutes until the vehicle was towed from the scene and the road fully reopened. This caused some evening commute delays. Speer was cited for Negligent Operation, a violation. The cause of the collision remains under investigation.
