On January 8, 2016 at 7:41 PM, the Hudson Police and Hudson Fire Departments responded to the intersection of Webster Street at Sunland Drive for a motor vehicle accident involving a pedestrian. Upon the officers arrival they conducted an on-scene investigation. It was determined that a female pedestrian was walking west over Webster Street near Sunland Drive. While the female pedestrian was in the roadway she was struck by a 1999 Jeep Wrangler, driven by a male subject, traveling northbound on Webster Street. The Hudson Fire EMT's transported the female pedestrian to the SNHRMC for serious but non-life threatening injuries.

At the time of the accident, the male driver of the Jeep was the lone occupant, he was wearing his seat belt and there was no air bag deployment.

During the investigation, portions of Webster Street were closed for about one hour. Drugs, alcohol and speed do not appear to be factors in the accident. The investigation remains under investigation by the Hudson Police Department.

The Hudson Police Department would like to thank the nearby residents and passing motorists for blocking the roadway and rendering First Aid to the female pedestrian until emergency personnel arrived on scene.
