ITINERARY

Day One: On this 4-day Pennsylvania tour, you will get to experience some of the great things that this part of the country has to offer such as the Amish Countryside, Longwood Gardens, Sight and Sound Theatre with the 30th Anniversary of "Noah" and of course delectable meals! Your group will be picked up at their usual pick up point. You will have rest stops and a luncheon stop en route (on your own) along the way. Your 3-night accommodations, The Country Inn of Lancaster (717-393-3413) is conveniently located in the Heart of Lancaster County, known to specialize in comfort, cleanliness, and country charm. The Inn offers an indoor pool and a pub for your enjoyment. You will have time to relax before your dinner at a local restaurant. Prepare your taste buds for some delicious traditional Penn Dutch cooking!

Day Two: A Buffet Breakfast is included at the Inn this morning. You will be visiting nearby Manheim for a farm tour and wine tasting with lunch today. At Kreider Farm, this will be a one of a kind farm experience! You will start out in the Welcome Center and see an introductory video before your tour of the farm begins. Then, get ready to take a drive (on the bus) right through the middle of the Moo-ternity Barn! It's not uncommon to see newborn calves either just born or being born. Next, it's a visit to the Milking Merry-Go-Round where you will take a short walk to the milking area. You'll get a bird's eye view of the milking merry-go-round where they milk 1,700 cows, 3 times a day! Enjoy a delicious free sample of farm fresh milk or chocolate milk. The last stop is the 100-foot-high Silo Observation Tower. You may choose to climb to the top for an excellent view of Kreider Farms and the surrounding Lancaster County farmland if you wish. After your tour of the farm is over, you will be visiting the Mount Hope Winery for a wine tasting and Farm-to-Table Experience. Lancaster County is known for farm-fresh food and the Manheim area is filled with vast farmland and lush crops. Your hosts will guide you on a journey of delicious food from the farm to the table. You will be dining today in a beautifully restored, historic barn featuring a hearty menu that changes seasonally to bring the finest and freshest items available, sourced as locally as possible. Learn about the history of agriculture in Lancaster County and about the sources of the items on the menu as well as enjoying some of the delectable wines that this winery has to offer. You will have some time back at the Inn this afternoon before we head out for the evening. The Chalk Talk is something that engages your senses through music, storytelling and amazing chalk artistry. Learn about the Amish culture with a story that comes to life and lights up before your eyes. Dinner is included tonight at a local restaurant served family style.

Day Three: Breakfast is included again at the hotel this morning. After breakfast, you will have a local guided tour of the area, as well as visit an Amish School and home. Lunch today will be on your own at the Kitchen Kettle Village with over 40 shops offering homemade Lancaster County food, and fresh baked goods. After lunch you will travel to the breathtaking Sight & Sound Theatre where you will see an afternoon performance of "Noah!"
