DPW offices are open Monday-Thursday 6:00am – 4:00pm - 2 Constitution Drive, Hudson. The number of passes automatically issued is three. The Town will soon be announcing a new policy to allow residents to purchase additional passes at the start of the 24-25 fiscal year: July 1.**
