

# TOWN OF HUDSON

## A GUIDE TO YOUR TRASH & RECYCLING SERVICE

- **Trash** is collected every week and **recycling** is collected every other week on your collection day.
- If your collection day falls on a **holiday**, there will be a one day delay in service. All subsequent collection days that week will also be delayed one day.

### Details About Your Curbside Collection

**Trash Collection:** One 65 gallon container provided by the Town

Your trash container may be placed curbside weekly for trash collection. If your household generates additional trash that cannot be handled with one cart, you may subscribe to **Overflow Trash Collection** service with Casella.



**Overflow Trash Collection:** Subscription service through Casella

For those with greater trash needs Casella is providing overflow service for an annual fee of \$219.48. The subscription period will run from July 1 to June 30, and will be pro-rated for those subscribing after the start date. Full year subscriptions will not be prorated for early removals. Subscription customers will receive a second cart, with a yellow lid, which can be placed curbside along with the cart provided by the Town. At the end of the subscription period, if you choose NOT to renew, Casella will remove the cart. **Recycling Collection:** One 96 gallon cart

Zero-Sort Recycling allows all accepted recyclables to be placed in one 96-gallon cart, and is collected bi-weekly. If you need more capacity, you can buy an additional 65-gallon cart for \$95 or a 95-gallon cart for \$125 by calling Casella at **800-675-7933**. Cardboard and paper can also be dropped off at the Town's Transfer Station during open dates, and yard waste dates.

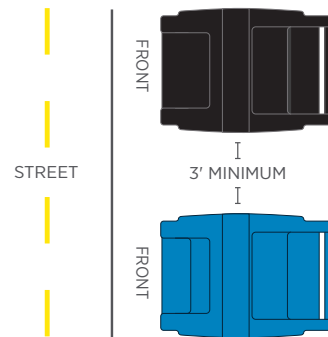


### Guidelines for Automated Collection

- All trash should be bagged and placed in the black container with the black lid, and the lid closed. **Trash left beside the container or in other containers will not be collected.**
- Collection containers must be set in an accessible location. Containers that are inaccessible will not be serviced until the following week. [See container placement guide >](#)
- **Containers must be at the curb by 6:30 AM on your collection day.** See curbside collection day street index and calendar for your collection day.
- No hazardous waste, building materials, yard waste, brush, liquids, ash, or recyclables should be placed in the trash containers.
- Blue recycling containers should be placed following the same guidelines as trash containers. Recyclables must be placed loose, not in bags. Flattened cardboard overflow is allowed above the cart, within reason. **Items outside the cart won't be collected.**

### PROPER CONTAINER PLACEMENT

Put containers on a hard, level surface clear of obstructions such as snow, landscaping, mailboxes, and utility poles. Do not block the sidewalk.



### CONTAINER DON'TS



Containers must remain upright for pickup



Keep all materials inside the container



Do not place containers back to back



Keep container clear of all obstructions

### Container Information & Barcoding

Hudson residents receive one free trash container and one recycling container as part of the automated collection program. These containers are owned by Casella and must not be modified or defaced. Recycling helps reduce trash volume and saves the Town of Hudson money, benefiting taxpayers. Containers are barcoded to the assigned residential address and must remain there. Overflow trash service includes an additional container with a yellow lid, also barcoded to the residence. Containers cannot be loaned, sold, or exchanged. Any misplaced containers will be scanned and returned to the correct address.

### Missing or Damaged Containers

If a container is destroyed, a replacement will be provided free of charge upon the return of the damaged container. Missing containers will be replaced upon notification to Casella. Damaged containers will be repaired at no cost to residents. Call Casella at **800-675-7933** and provide details of the needed repair (e.g., lid, wheel).

# Additional Information

## Town of Hudson Transfer Station Open Dates

0 Old Landfill Rd, Hudson, NH • 8:00 AM-12:00 PM

- January 25, 2025
- February 22, 2025
- March 29, 2025
- April 12 & 26, 2025
- May 10 & 31, 2025
- June 14 & 28, 2025

Each residence serviced by curbside collection will be entitled to **three passes** per calendar year.

Up to three additional passes may be purchased for \$30.00 each by personal check made out to the Town of Hudson, NH. This excludes mattresses and box springs.

Effective January 1, 2025 mattresses and box springs will require a special pass. The cost is \$35.00 for each mattress and each box spring payable by personal check made out to the Town of Hudson, NH.

Passes are valid for that calendar year for which they are issued, and will expire on December 31 of every year.

Passes may be obtained at the Public Works Department during normal business hours. Residents will be required to show a valid picture ID to be issued passes for their address. A valid picture ID will also be required at the transfer station to match to the pass.

A pass will be required to dispose of any acceptable items per visit, not per day.

The Town is not responsible for lost or stolen passes and will not issue replacements.

**Acceptable Items:** Demolition and building materials, clean sheetrock, clean asphalt shingles, clean wood, brush, leaves, furniture, rugs, cardboard, appliances, and scrap metal. Branches should be no greater than 5" in diameter.

**Unacceptable Items:** Freon appliances, TVs/CRTs, household trash, gas, oil, or batteries.

In addition to the above listed dates, residents have access to curbside collection and dumpster service from Casella for the items listed above. Please call for rates or to schedule collection at **800-675-7933**.

## Residential Pick-up Of Bulky & White Goods

Hudson residents may call Casella at **800-675-7933** to schedule a curbside pick-up of any of the items listed below. This service will be provided once per month.

**User fees for this service are as follows:** \$48.40 per item. All freon appliances, TV and CRT monitors, metal appliances, and non-metal goods (plastic appliances, couches, mattresses, rugs, etc.).

**Note:** The user fee for these items will increase to \$53.24 effective July 1, 2025.

**Payment:** Credit card or check payable to Casella

## Yard Waste, Metal & Cardboard

**The Transfer Station:** Open April-November on Saturdays from 8:00 AM-12:00 PM for cardboard, metal and yard waste only. No passes are required.

**Curbside Yard Waste Collection:** Saturday, December 6, 2025 beginning at 7:00 AM.

**Curbside Yard Waste Guidelines:** Barrels and biodegradable leaf bags Only. No containers over 75 pounds in weight. Brush should be bundled with twine and no larger than 2' in diameter and 3' long.

## 2025 Hazardous Waste Disposal

The Town of Hudson coordinates with the Nashua Regional Planning Commission to provide Household Hazardous Waste Collection Days for our residents. Full details, including dates and locations are available online at [nashuarpc.org](http://nashuarpc.org) or call **603-417-6570**.

\$20 User Fee per Vehicle: Covers 10-gallons or 20-pounds. Cash or check payable to NRSWMD.

**Accepted Items:** Pesticide, insecticide, herbicide, rodent killer, drain cleaner, varnish, coal tar driveway sealer, muriatic acid, antifreeze, mixed gasoline, paint thinner, oil and lead based paint, paint stripper, oven cleaner, photo chemicals, Ni-CAD and lithium batteries, pool chemicals. **NO LATEX PAINT.**
